PURPOSE

This policy sets out the requirements for entry into Victorian government schools. Schooling is compulsory for all children aged between six and 17 in Victoria, unless granted an exemption from attendance has been granted.

POLICY

Pyramid Hill College holds the belief that school participation is important as it maximizes life opportunities for children and young people by providing them with education and support networks.

It also helps children and young people to develop important skills, knowledge and values which set them up for further learning and participation in their community.

Aims:

To support the access of education to every eligible child through correct enrolment processes **Implementation**:

In order to support the enrolment of eligible students the following guidelines will be implemented:

- ♣ Interview to be held with the appropriate Neighbourhood Manager/Assistant Principal/ Principal
- ♣ Parent/carer to fill out an enrolment form at the school providing the school with important information about the student
- ♣ Evidence of child's date of birth
- A Parent/carers contact details, including phone number and address, and those of any other parent, guardian and/or carer
- Names and contact details of emergency contacts
- A Doctor's and dentist's names and phone numbers
- ♣ Immunisation Status Certificate
- ♣ Health and welfare information
- Information about the language/s the child speaks and hears at home.
- ♣ Enrolment forms are available at the Office. If a parent/carer requires support to fill out the enrolment form, the school staff can help organise this support.
- ♣ Enrolment Packages will contain all required information for parents/carers including College handbook and other operational information

- Discussed at staff meetings/briefings as required
- Made available publicly on our school website
- Made available in hard copy from school administration upon request
